CSW Volunteers is the volunteering "arm" of the organisation and achieved Investors in Volunteering (iV) accreditation for 2nd time in May 2018. We recruit and place people into exciting and essential volunteering opportunities that support a broad range of our services.

We offer volunteering in a supportive and flexible environment. We give you access to a wide range of training opportunities which will help support the volunteering role you choose but will also enhance your own CV.

Your life skills, experience and motivation can make a difference to another individual. Volunteering gives you the opportunity to experience "The Feel-good factor" boost your confidence, improve your employability and might even improve your health. One thing we guarantee is you'll meet new people and make new friends. We can open up a world of new experiences through short term and longer term options.

About the role of Young People Engagement – Digital Skills Group Volunteer

This role is available for Volunteers in Paignton area.

CSW Transitions team work with Young People aged 13-19 who are disadvantaged through physical or learning disabilities, Mental Ill Health or other social/physical issue. The young people we work with need assistance and support with a range of life skills in order to achieve their goals and successfully move forward into the next stage of their lives. Through our support we are able to ensure each young person understands the local labor market and how their skills can align to potential career opportunities. We engage with them through their schools, colleges and communities.

The Young People we work with need assistance and support with a range of life skills in order to achieve their goals and successfully move forward into the next stage of their lives.

The role of Digital Skills Group Volunteer enhances the support we can offer the Young People CSW Transitions Team we are in contact with.

Volunteers will facilitate and support our new weekly Digital Skills sessions to help young people to use a computer for a range of things necessary for their daily lives:

Learn basic IT skills

Use the internet and email

Use on-line job websites and apply for jobs

register and use the Universal Job Match & National Apprenticeships websites

Develop, create or update their CV

Group sessions will run weekly Mondays 2 - 4.00 pm (days and times could be changed dependent on your availability)

Sessions will run for 2 hours but volunteers will need to available minimum of 15 minutes before and after to allow for time to set up and pack away.

2 volunteers per session - could be weekly, fortnightly or monthly commitment per volunteer (dependent on your availability)

These sessions will be very informal with a friendly and inclusive approach. The digital support provided to a young person will be individual dependent on what they want to achieve and will be delivered at a pace that suits them.

Volunteers will be linked to a member of the Transitions team who will provide regular contact, supervision and support.

What are we looking for?

You don't have to be an expert or highly trained just have good ICT knowledge, good people skills and a willingness to help a young person to increase their skills and potential.

Volunteers need to be adaptable, flexible and most of all a good communicator.

Have good Listening skills

Keen to inspire the next generation, but at the same time talk about the realities of life.

Will you be able to encourage to Young Person to explore their natural skills and abilities and most of all boost their confidence

Experience of working with young people not essential

Experience in CV writing an advantage but not essential as guidance will be given

Practical Considerations

DBS not required for this role

Contact details for 2 referees required

Volunteers must be over 16 years old

Travel expenses will be reimbursed

Able to commit to minimum of 3 hours volunteering per month

Able to attend face to face Volunteer Induction session and complete units of online training which will be provided by CSW Group

The venue that these group sessions will run is situated upstairs and no lift is available therefore may not be suitable for volunteers with poor mobility.
